## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Junior Grand Prix is a Rochester Community Tennis event designed to promote low cost tennis competition among juniors of all ages and abilities in the Rochester community. The Junior Grand Prix (JGP) has been an annual event since 1991. It is a Rochester community event, administered by Rochester Community Tennis (RCT), a not for profit organization formed through the volunteer efforts of tennis professionals, local tennis clubs and parents. The generous sponsorships of local businesses help defray the costs.

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

### Format:

- The early rounds will be round robin in separate flights; with regular set scoring in subsequent rounds.

### Entry Fee:

### Circuit Rules:

#### **USTA Membership is Not Required.**

- Absolutely no phone or e-mail entries will be accepted
- Players must finish tournament to receive Grand Prix points.
- Tournament Director may, at his/her discretion, alter format if necessary to facilitate timely play.
- 10-minute default rule will be strictly enforced. Please arrive before scheduled match time.
- It is players' responsibility to confirm starting times via the website.
- Tournament Director reserves the right to place players in appropriate age group to provide fair competition.

### Penalty for not showing up

For each Grand Prix Tournament a player is registered to play and fails to show up, he or she will lose the points from one tournament (the one that the highest points were earned), unless they notify the Tournament Director by Tuesday 5:00 PM of the week of the tournament. There is also a \$15 penalty to play in the next tournament and the player must confirm via e-mail their intent to play remaining events.

### Sportsmanship Award

A male and a female player from each age group exhibiting the best example of etiquette and sportsmanship will receive an award.
